What is the Home from Hospital Service?

Following a stay in hospital we can help smooth the process of settling back into a normal routine and help you regain a sense of confidence and independence.

Our trained volunteers can provide companionship whilst assisting you with everyday tasks such as shopping and collecting prescriptions.

How can I get help?

You can ask the person arranging your discharge to call us. You can also refer yourself to the service within two weeks of your discharge from hospital.

How can the Home from Hospital Service help me?

Once a week for up to 6 weeks from the date that you leave hospital, our trained Red Cross volunteers can:

- > Help you with shopping
- > Provide companionship
- > Collect prescriptions
- > Contact local cleaning and laundry services
- > Arrange maintenance around the home
- > Find other local benefits/extra support

We cannot:

Provide personal health care (eg washing/dressing)

Administer medication or change dressings

Lift or move someone

Provide a laundry service
